Community based Alcohol and Drug Services (ADRS, CATs, Integrated Teams) will support, advise and assist patients to think about the ways in which alcohol or drugs are affecting their life, those around them and those they have responsibility for. When a patient attends a community based service their needs will be assessed. This involves asking a range of questions and listening to the responses. It is a joint decision as to what treatment and support is needed in the short and long term.
