



Care Needs Cared for at Home

Proportion of People with Complex

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60.2% of people with complex care needs were being cared for at home, an improvement on last years' performance of **59.8%**.

Across NHSScotland, the proportion was 60.7%.

Current performance is below the Scottish average of 73.5%.

Early Years



In 2017, **87.8%** of babies were of healthy birth weight (appropriate weight for gestational age).

Current performance represents a decrease on the 88.7% reported last year and remains positive given our high levels of deprivation.

NHSScotland's figure was 89.1% for the same period.

Cancer Waiting Times



92.7% of eligible patients began cancer treatment within 31 days of decision to treat at March 2018.

NHSGGC's performance was below **NHSScotland's** position of **93.5%** for March 2018.
