

Performance at a Glance: 2017-18 Local Delivery Plan Standards

As at March 2018, our performance against the 2017-18 Local Delivery Plan Standards was as follows:

<p>✓ 89.3% of our patients were treated within 18 weeks of Referral To Treatment against a target of 90%.</p>	<p>✗ The number of MRSA/MSSA Bacteraemia cases was above target.</p>
<p>✓ We continued to exceed the 90% drug and alcohol waiting times target with 94.5% of patients referred to treatment seen within three weeks.</p>	<p>✗ 81.3% of patients referred urgently with a suspicion of cancer began treatment within 62 days of receipt of referral below the target of 95% and 92.7% of our patients diagnosed with cancer began treatment within 31 days against a target of 95%.</p>
<p>✓ We achieved the C Difficile Infections reduction target during 2017-18.</p>	<p>✗ Performance in relation to accident and emergency four hour wait remained challenging reporting 86.7% of patients waiting four hours or less at March 2018.</p>
<p>✓ 88.7% of patients who started their treatment in the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services started treatment within 18 weeks of referral against a target of 90%.</p>	<p>✗ 74.5% of our new outpatients seen had been waiting 12 weeks or less following first referral below the target of 90%.</p>
<p>✓ 91.9% of patients referred for a psychological therapy started treatment within 18 weeks of referral.</p>	<p>✗ 78.7% of eligible inpatients/day cases were seen within the 12 week Treatment Time Guarantee below the target of 90%.</p>
<p>✓ We delivered a total of 14,957 alcohol brief interventions against the planned number of 13,086 interventions.</p>	<p>✗ Our rate of sickness absence across NHSGGC was 5.51% for the year ending March 2018, above the 4% target and marginally above NHSScotland's position of 5.39%.</p>
<p>✓ We remained in financial balance and met the cash efficiency target whilst at the same time delivering on a range of major service developments and improvements.</p>	
<p>✓ 100% of eligible patients were screened for IVF treatment within 12 months exceeding the target of 90%.</p>	
<p>✓ There were a total of 2,017 successful smoking quits at three months post quit from our 40% most deprived areas exceeding our annual target of 2,005.</p>
