

Information about your first appointment

At this appointment we will take routine bloods and swabs. This is to make sure that you do not have any infections before you start your treatment.

You will also need to bring evidence of two MMR vaccinations, you can get this from your GP.

You will also need to have an up to date cervical smear test. If possible please bring a copy of your test result with you. Please make sure it remains in date throughout your treatment. If you are unsure please contact your GP.

Please bring photographic ID with you and as your partner does not have to attend this appointment, please ask them to bring photographic ID to their next appointment.

Please be aware that travel just before or during treatment may have an impact as certain areas are at risk of infection. Risk of certain infection e.g. Zika or Ebola means a delay to your treatment or storage of your eggs as there can be serious consequences to pregnancy.
