Early Weather Warning – Storm Floris

An early yellow weather warning for wind has been issued across Scotland from Monday morning through to Tuesday morning, linked to Storm Floris. Forecasts currently indicate the potential for unseasonably strong winds, with gusts of 60–70mph inland and up to 80mph along some coastlines. A period of heavy rain may also bring localised flooding and hazardous conditions.

We ask all managers and staff to familiarise themselves with the Adverse Weather Policy and ensure local preparedness measures are in place.

A further update will be provided on Sunday, when the forecast is clearer.
