NHSGGC Flying Start Portal – Protected study days one and two – additional dates

The Practice Education team have added additional dates for <u>Flying Start Protected Study Days</u> one and two, for those NQPs who may have missed the November/ December dates.



Flying Start NHS® is the national development programme that the

Scottish Government and NHSGGC requires all registered nurses, midwives and allied health professionals (AHPs) to complete, in their first year in practice. Each Newly Qualified Practitioner (NQP) within NHSGGC, should be afforded 24 hours protected learning time away from the workplace to support completion of the programme within the first year.

The study days facilitated by the Practice Education team provides opportunity for peer support and discussion, development of evidence for your portfolio, supports CPD whilst highlighting other relevant information, which clarifies Flying Start NHS[®] programme requirements.
