## **Spiritual Care Service – Hours of availability**

The Spiritual Care Service at NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde provides confidential, compassionate, and inclusive spiritual, pastoral and bereavement support to patients, families, and staff of all backgrounds, beliefs, and none.

The Spiritual Care Service is available for everyone in acute and mental health sites during the following hours:

- **Monday to Friday, 8.00am – 4.00pm:** Spiritual care support is available from Registered Chaplains, who will assess and respond to spiritual care need as appropriate (within a maximum of 72 hours for routine referrals, where possible). The team provide emotional and spiritual support, and work alongside multidisciplinary teams to meet the needs of individuals and families.
- **Monday to Friday, 4.00pm – 9.00pm:** An on-call chaplain is available to respond to **urgent referrals only**.
- **Weekends and public holidays, 8.00am – 9.00pm:** On-call provision is in place for **urgent referrals only**.


Access to Spiritual Care remains simple: contact switchboard on 0141 201 0000 and request the on-call chaplain.

If you or patients require a Roman Catholic priest at any time, contact switchboard and request the on call Roman Catholic Priest

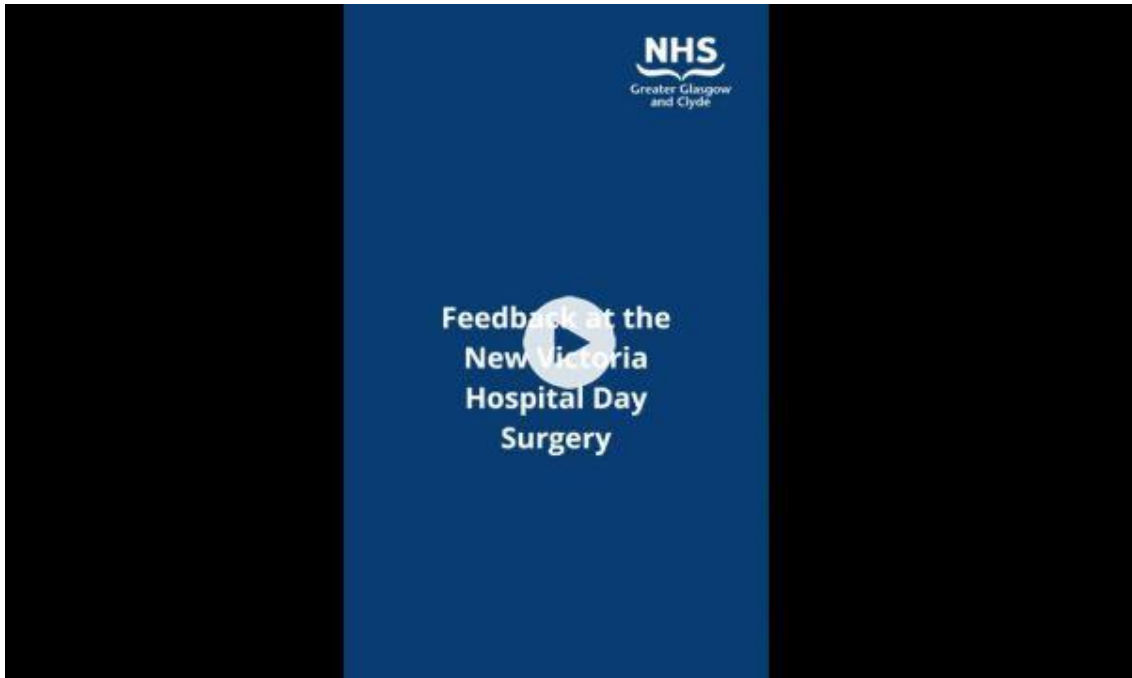
## **Feedback Friday**
