Today marks the start of Diabetes Week (Monday 10 to Sunday 16 June 2024) and we're asking you to join us in spreading the word about patient support available.

The free, online, <u>NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde Type 2 Diabetes Hub</u> hosts information to help anyone who needs support to self-manage their Type 2 Diabetes or support a family member or friend in doing so. The hub includes information on what Type 2 Diabetes is, the symptoms, and how it can be managed via eating and movement – including recipes, cooking demos, and exercise.

<u>Control IT Plus</u> can also be accessed via the hub. This is a lifestyle programme for people who have been diagnosed with, or are at risk of developing, Type 2 Diabetes. It is delivered online by a range of NHSGGC health professionals, across two interactive sessions.
