Important notice: Discontinue use of Tiger Medical Products Eyewear in COVID-19 setting

NHS Scotland has received correspondence from the UK Department of Health and Social Care in relation to a particular make of disposable eyewear provided via the UK Pandemic Stock pile. Staff are advised to no longer use the following disposable eyewear in a COVID-19 setting (also pictured below):

Tiger Medical Products: Protective Goggles and Frames Product Codes PG0001 – F and PG0001-K Barcode for frames: 6948548400224 NPC for Frames (BTP083 and BTP403) and Lenses (BTP097, BTP404 and BTP439)

In line with guidance, staff may already have used the above Tiger Eye Protector product for non-Aerosol Generating Procedures. The DHSC states the risk from using it in direct patient contact when not performing AGPs is limited. No further stock of these will be issued from NHSGGC procurement.

Please ensure any stocks you may have are quarantined until further notice.

Alternative eyewear is being distributed across the organisation through the course of today and tomorrow to supplement existing stocks.
