DCN Early Adopter to go live in Nursing

The Digital Clinical Notes (DCN) Nursing Programme Team are pleased to confirm the go live date for the Early Adopter wards **Philipshill and Edenhall will be Tuesday 18 April 2023 with Ward 65 expected to follow, week commencing 8 May 2023.**



The DCN programme, is an exciting and innovative multi-professional approach to digitalise clinical documentation on TrakCare © within NHSGGC.

The nursing documentation currently used to assess, plan and evaluate patient's care will now be available as a digital record within TrakCare ©.

A number of outpatient services are already benefiting from implementing DCN including MSK Physiotherapy, Weight Management and most recently Paediatric Dental services.

As more services adopt DCN as the primary recording tool for clinical information there may be a requirement for you to view the patient record on TrakCare ©.

Emergency Road Closure – Moss Road

We have been notified by Scottish Gas Networks (SGN), that Moss Road will be closed at its junction with the A739 Clyde Tunnel access road from Wednesday 12 April for emergency repairs. This closure will affect all road users travelling to the QEUH via Moss Road. There is no further information at this stage on how long the closure will be in place for.

Vehicles leaving the hospital will be unaffected, however all vehicles travelling to the hospital via Moss Road will be diverted as follows:

- M8 Eastbound traffic: Helen Street – Harmony Row – Golspie Street – Govan Road
- M8 Westbound/Berryknowes Road traffic: Fifty Pitches Road – A8 Shieldhall Road – Renfrew Road
- A8 Shieldhall Road traffic: Langlands Road – Drive Road – Govan Road
- A739 Traffic: A739 Clyde Tunnel – A814 Victoria Park Drive South – A739 Clyde Tunnel – Govan Road.

Please allow additional time for travel as this closure is likely to cause delays, particularly at peak times.
