Achtichlor Plus is being replaced by Titan Chlor Plus



Titan Chlor Plus Tablets will replace Actichlor Plus. Application and dilution is the same. Add 1 tablet to 1 litre of water to get 1000 ppm AvCl solution. Add 1 tablet to 100mls water to give 10,000 ppm AvCl. Both tablets have 1.7g Troclosesene as the active ingredient.



Ecolabs Actichlor Plus, the chlorine releasing disinfectant product used widely throughout NHSGGC for all environmental disinfection cleaning, including blood and bodily spillages is being replaced by Titan Chlor.

A product training video will be issued, along with the COSHH/HSE documentation, to all clinical leads. A new information poster will also be provided to replace the ones from Ecolab. Please remove all Ecolab posters and replace with the ones from Diversey once received.

The Pecos purchase process will not change, and orders for Actichlor will automatically be replaced with Titan Chlor. Going forward any dosing bottles should be ordered from PECOS, using code **183319 Titan Chlor Plus dosing bottles 6pc**.

Save Money on Public Transport with Annual Season Tickets

Our Annual Travel Ticket Scheme provides staff employed by NHSGGC the opportunity to purchase a range of annual public transport season tickets and repay the cost via salary deductions, making travel more cost effective by spreading the cost across the year. Through work undertaken by the Sustainable Travel & Transport Group, the scheme has been amended, removing the restriction that staff could not purchase an annual season ticket, which was greater than 10% of their annual salary. This makes an annual season ticket more affordable and accessible for more of our staff.
