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Fraud Awareness – Mythbusters

Fraud awareness is everyone's responsibility. To support colleagues in understanding the role we all play in protecting NHS resources, we've recorded a short Mythbusters video featuring Michelle Wailes, Non-Executive Board Member and Chair of the Audit and Risk Committee, and Euan Cronin, Fraud Liaison Officer.

In the video, Michelle and Euan tackle three common misconceptions about fraud at NHSGGC, including who is responsible for reporting concerns, what effective fraud prevention looks like, and the different forms fraud can take.
