New functionality in TrakCare

We are pleased to announce the launch of new TrakCare functionality enabling clinical and administrative staff to send an **electronic copy of clinical letters directly to the patient's GP**. This enhancement supports improved communication and continuity of care across NHSGGC.

It introduces a new checkbox on the letter screen that allows users to send a copy electronically to the GP, removing the need to print and post. This applies to the following six letter types (found under Menu 'Letters Generic'):

- Clinical Summary Letter to Patient
- Referral Letter
- Transfer Letter
- MDT Letter
- Social Services Letter
- Clinical Letter

This development has been a joint collaboration between clinical services and eHealth, shaped by feedback from users across multiple specialties.

We are confident that this functionality will bring several key benefits:

- Improved patient safety through timely delivery of clinical information to GPs.
- **Streamlined workflows**, reducing reliance on manual printing and postal processes.
- **Greater efficiency**, enabling staff to manage correspondence directly within TrakCare.

Looking ahead, eHealth continues to work on further enhancements to TrakCare that will support integrated care and reduce administrative burden.

As we prepare for the Go-Live date - currently scheduled for the 18th August, we encourage all users to familiarise themselves with this new functionality via the linked user reference guide.

The new Staffnet site, launched in June 2023, has replaced the old site.
