Introducing the Updated Clinical Quality Publication Framework and Toolkit

We are pleased to announce the launch of the updated Clinical Quality Publication (CQP) Framework and Toolkit, approved by the Board Clinical Governance Forum in October 2025. These resources are designed to ensure that NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde (NHSGGC) has an efficient system in place to track, disseminate, review and respond to the latest clinical quality publications.

What is the CQP Framework?

The CQP Framework provides a structured approach for identifying, reviewing, and acting on key clinical quality publications. These include national standards, evidence-based guidelines, and benchmarking reports. Its aim is to ensure the Board is aware of the most recent publications, to provide assurance that the current position in relation to publications is known, and to ensure that any actions in response to the publication can be agreed.

What is the CQP Toolkit?

The CQP Toolkit is a practical, user-friendly resource designed to support the CQP Framework. It brings together essential tools and guidance to help lead reviewers and review groups to navigate the CQP review process. The resource includes FAQs, a timeline infographic, detailed explanations of the publication types involved in the process, a risk assessment matrix, and guidance flowcharts for lead reviewers, highlighting roles and responsibilities. A new questionnaire is also featured to gather feedback on the CQP process.
