On the evening of Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May, an access scaffold will begin to be erected within the atrium of the Queen Elizabeth University Hospital.

The scaffold will be in place for approximately two weeks, to allow for technical due diligence checks to take place ahead of works commencing later in the year.

As a result a small section of the Aroma Café mezzanine will be closed. Aroma Café opening times will not be affected.
