Flu and COVID-19 vaccination drop-in clinics from midday to midnight

As we rapidly progress into a busy winter on our wards, we would like staff to be protected as much as they can be against flu and COVID-19.

If you haven't yet received your winter vaccinations, we encourage you to attend the following drop-in clinics in the coming weeks. The clinics will operate from midday to midnight, to make it easier for evening and nightshift staff to attend.
