## Infection Prevention and Control: Cleaning near patient equipment

Your feedback is so important in helping us understand the challenges around cleaning near-patient equipment and in generating ideas to better support staff in this area.

Around 5% of hospital patients acquire infections, some of which can be severe or fatal. Any patient-contact equipment can transfer bacteria, which can cause infection. Items like infusion pumps, BP cuffs, weighing scales, therapy toys, trolleys, wheelchairs etc if not cleaned between uses, may become critical sources of harmful bacteria.
