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Spotlight on Discharge Without Delay: Daily DwD Board Rounds

This week, we're focusing on **Daily DwD Board Rounds**.

Regular board rounds help teams maintain a shared understanding of every patient's discharge journey, supporting realistic discharge planning and meaningful Planned Dates of Discharge. They provide an opportunity to identify actions, resolve issues quickly and escalate barriers where necessary.

By bringing multidisciplinary teams together around a common plan, Daily DwD Board Rounds help improve communication, support patient flow and keep discharge at the forefront of daily care. Acute wards are encouraged to undertake these reviews regularly throughout the day.
