### **Launch of the Carer Leave Guide and Carer Passport**

We are delighted to introduce two new resources designed to strengthen the support available to staff with caring responsibilities outside of work: the Carer Leave Guide and the NHSGGC Carer Passport.

These have been created with our staff, for our staff — shaped directly by the thoughtful insights shared during our 2025 Collaborative Conversations and through our growing Carer MS Teams community. Many staff shared the challenges they face balancing work with caring responsibilities and highlighted the need for clearer, more accessible support.

#### **Carer Leave Guide**

This brings all key information together in one place, including:

- Understanding the types of carer leave available
- Knowing the difference between planned and unforeseen leave
- What to do if a request is refused
- Where to find further help and support

#### **NHSGGC Carer Passport**

A voluntary, supportive tool to help you and your manager have meaningful, constructive conversations about your caring responsibilities. Using the Passport can help you:

- Share what you're comfortable disclosing about your caring role
- Explore flexible working or leave options
- Record agreed adjustments
- Maintain continuity of support even if your manager changes

The Guide and Passport are designed to complement existing policies such as the Once for Scotland Special Leave, and Flexible Working policies.

Thank you to everyone who contributed experiences, insight, and feedback throughout this process. Your engagement has helped shape resources that will benefit colleagues

across NHSGGC.
