New HSCP Chief Officer Announced

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East Dunbartonshire Health and Social Care Partnership has appointed Derrick Pearce as its new Chief Officer.

Derrick took up the role of Interim Chief Officer in July 2024, and now, following a robust recruitment and selection process conducted jointly between the Council and NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde, has secured the role on a permanent basis.



Derrick was previously Head of Community Health and Care Services at East Dunbartonshire HSCP for over six years and before that spent a decade in Health and Social Care roles in Inverclyde.

Ann Davie, Chief Executive, East Dunbartonshire Council said, "I am pleased to announce that Derrick Pearce has been appointed the new Chief Officer of East Dunbartonshire HSCP.
