While there is already a lot of work going on, the theme of collaborative working is an important one because there is no one organisation that can provide the variety of support that veterans need and deserve to stay living well in our community. The day was a great success, sharing information about current and future initiatives to support veterans and their families, and to foster even better collaborative working.

NHSGGC is providing welfare support to veterans in acute care through a professional partnership with Defence Medical Welfare Service. DMWS Welfare Officers will provide bedside support, helping the veteran to tackle any non-clinical issues impacting on their recovery and overall wellbeing. The Welfare Officers also support discharge planning and have been successful in helping some veterans access appropriate housing and with making adaptations to support independent living.
