## Care Opinion Annual Report 2022-2023

Care Opinion have, this month, published their annual report for 2022 - 2023 and we are delighted to announce that we have received the highest number of stories across Scotland. For the third year in a row we have also seen an increase in feedback shared in relation to NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde. Some highlights include:

- A 69% increase in the number of stories received by NHSGGC compared to the previous year
- 70% of stories were positive
- Our stories have been read 243,844 times.



When people were providing feedback much of what they valued related to the staff with words used such as 'professional', 'compassion', 'friendly' and 'communication'.

We thank all our patients, carers and visitors who have shared their experiences via Care Opinion, and to our staff who promote, respond and act on feedback.
