NHSGGC has launched a new section on its website to help patients support and improve their health.

My Health – www.nhsggc.scot/my-health - is a one-stop shop giving information on preparing for appointments, health and wellbeing advice and support to self-manage common health problems and conditions.



The site focuses on three themes:

- Preparing for appointments by encouraging patients to plan ahead
- Promoting self-care by maintaining a healthy lifestyle
- Providing tips and advice for self-managing common conditions.

The site is a useful tool for everyone but is particularly helpful for people with long term

conditions who often have multiple health issues, are less likely to have access to health information and may have to wait longer for appointments due to the complexity or variety of their conditions.

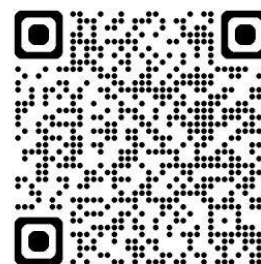
