Weather Warnings – Storm Amy

A number of weather warnings for wind have been issued throughout Scotland from Friday afternoon, linked to Storm Amy. A yellow warning is in place across the country from 5.00pm on Friday – 11.59pm on Saturday, while an amber warning is in place for some areas from 5.00pm on Friday – 9.00am on Saturday.

Forecasts currently indicate the potential for gusts of 50-60mph gusts likely widely across Scotland, with the 60-70mph possible for a time fairly widely. A period of heavy rain may also bring localised flooding and hazardous conditions.

We ask all managers and staff to familiarise themselves with the Adverse Weather Policy and ensure local preparedness measures are in place.

All hospitals will be open as usual tomorrow, and we encourage staff to make suitable arrangements for getting to work, and to check transport links for delays or cancellations.
