Importance of DATIX Submissions Following Fire Alarm Activations

There has been an increasing trend in fire alarm activations where a corresponding DATIX submission has **not** been completed by the relevant department.

DATIX submissions are essential for NHSGGC Fire Safety Officers to effectively investigate fire alarm activations. They enable the identification of trends in causes, support measures to reduce the likelihood of recurring incidents, and ensure that any significant or serious activations are appropriately reviewed and managed.

All departments are therefore reminded to [complete a DATIX report](#) following every fire alarm activation. Reports should include as much detail as possible to support thorough investigation and ongoing improvement in fire safety management across NHSGGC.
