To help promote this work, there will be activities happening in the IRH Dining Room from 1-7 May where staff can find more information about support available and also take part in activities which help us to remember those we miss.

Alongside this in-person event, there will be an online session on Bereavement in the Workplace on Wednesday 10 May from 10.30am-11.30am which will look at some of the NHSGGC policies available to support staff in a time of bereavement or whilst they are proving care for a friend or relative. Reporting salaries correctly

If you complete SSTS or eESS, or are a manager responsible for staff salaries, then we want your help in ensuring that staff are paid correctly and on time.

A simple way to do this is by making sure that all leave, absence, overtime and changes to pay are recorded and authorised on time and accurately through the appropriate systems in advance of payroll deadlines.
