Autumn/Winter Vaccination Programme 2022 – Flu & Covid Vaccination

This year's winter vaccination programme (Covid Booster and Flu Vaccination) starts on Monday 5 September and the booking portal will open in a couple of weeks. All NHSGGC staff are eligible for flu vaccination this year and all those working in patient / client areas are eligible for a further COVID vaccination.

We are asking staff to be prepared in advance of the booking system opening and ensure you have your username and password handy.

If you do not remember your Username or Password then follow the link to recover username or password. In order to do this you will require one date of a previous covid vaccination. If you have the status app you can use this to get the date of a vaccination

If you don't remember your login details you can phone the national vaccination helpline to make an appointment 0800 030 8013 (open from 8am to 8pm, 7 days a week).

If you've recently had coronavirus

If you have recently had a confirmed coronavirus infection, you should wait four weeks from date of test or first symptoms (whichever is earlier) to get the vaccine. You should do this even if you have no symptoms.
