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Scottish Hospitals Inquiry update

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As staff may be aware, the next stage of hearings of the Scottish Hospitals Public Inquiry begin on Monday 12 June 2023 and will run for approximately three weeks. A number of our staff will be giving evidence at these sessions and we are actively supporting them through this process.

We wanted to advise staff that as part of our response to the Public Inquiry and in line with the powers of the Inquiry under the Inquiries Act 2005, some documents and reports, including IMT and PAG meeting minutes, SBARS and some emails and expert reports have been published by the Scottish Hospitals Public Inquiry on their website.

Witness statements from NHSGGC staff will be published on the same website separately, and we understand that these will be published on the day the witness gives their oral evidence.

As a result, there may be names of staff contained within the documents that have been published. Examples will include where attendance is noted for the minute of a meeting.

Our Public Inquiry Programme Management Team has been providing guidance to line managers in order that staff members who may be included in this way, have been alerted ahead of the publication of the documents.
