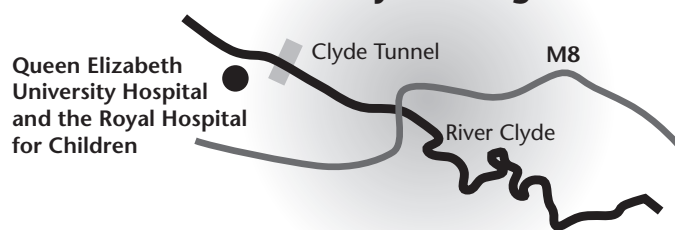

By Car

From the East or West of the City

M8 motorway to Junction 25. Follow signs for Clyde Tunnel (A739) for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile. Then follow signs for hospital. Turn left into Govan Road. The Hospital is on the left.

From north of the River Clyde

Go through the Clyde Tunnel (A739) and follow the signs for the hospital.



Car Parking

Car parking is free but there is a four hour maximum stay in operation Monday to Friday (7.30am – 4.00pm).



Disabled Parking

Disabled parking spaces are available on the ground floor of the multi-storey car parks.

By Rail or Subway to Hospitals

Govan Subway Station: A 25 minute walk to Govan Road entrance (just over 1 mile).

Buses to the hospital are First 26, McGill's F1 and Stagecoach X19. Local taxis also available.



Cardonald Station: A 25 minute walk to Langlands Drive entrance (just over 1 mile).

Buses to the hospital are First 34 and McGill's 17.

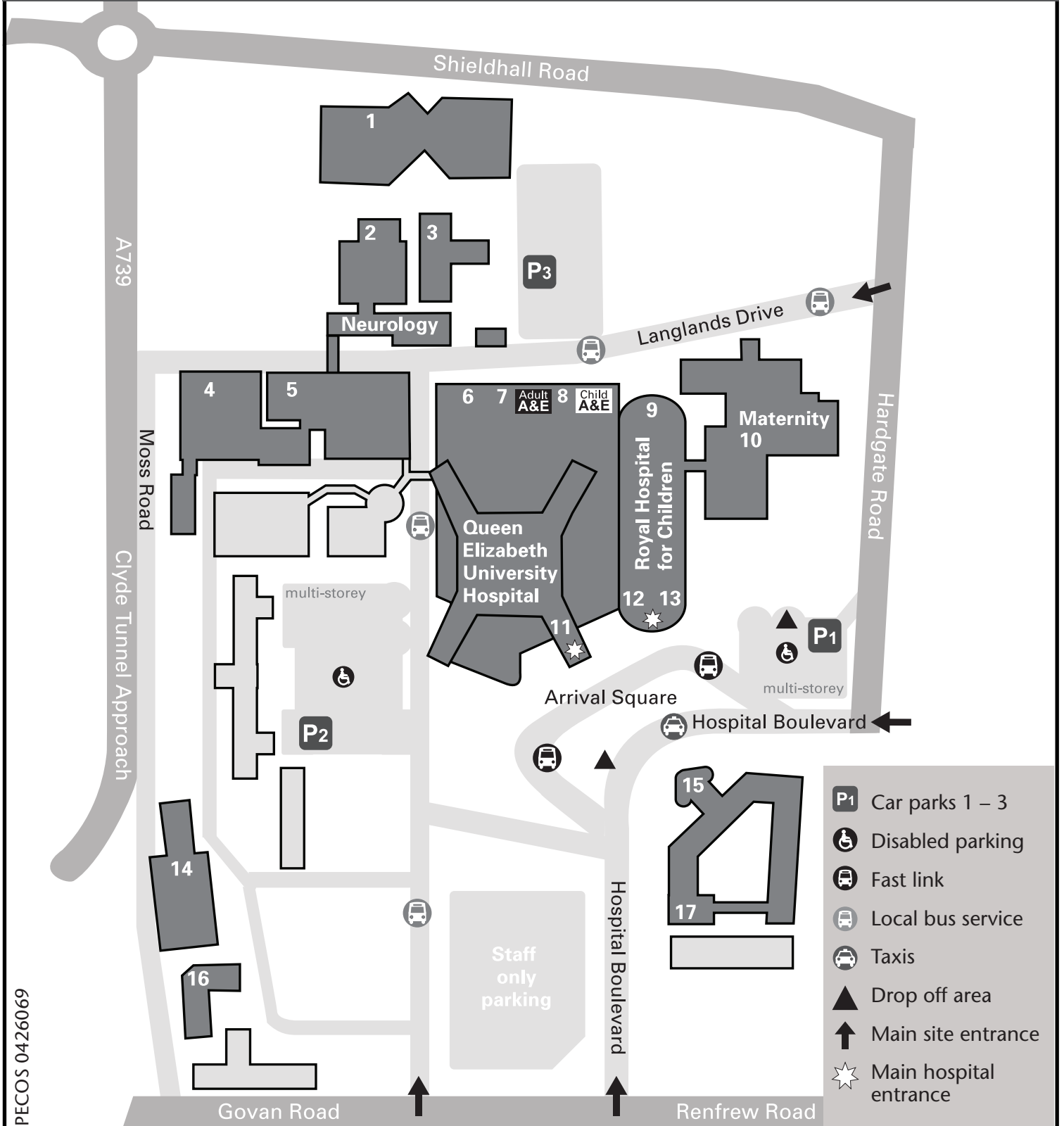


By Air
