

By Car

From the East or West of the City

M8 motorway to Junction 25. Follow signs for Clyde Tunnel (A739) for ¾ mile. Then follow signs for hospital. There are two entrances. Please see the map overleaf.

From north of the River Clyde

Go through the Clyde Tunnel (A739) and follow the signs for the hospital.

Car Parking

Car parking is free but there is a 4 hour maximum stay in operation Monday to Friday (7.30am – 4.00pm).

Disabled Parking

Located on the ground floor of P1 and P2 car parks, in P3, and in the hospital grounds.

By Rail or Subway to Hospitals

Govan Subway Station: A 25 minute walk to Govan Road entrance (just over 1 mile). Buses to the hospital are First 90, McGill's 21, 23, 23A and Stagecoach X19. Local taxis also available.


Cardonald Station: A 25 minute walk to Langlands Drive entrance (just over 1 mile). Buses to the hospital are First 34A; McGill's 17 and Colchri 25.

By Air

Glasgow Airport is 5 miles west of the hospital. Take M8 for Glasgow to Junction 25. Follow car directions above. The First Glasgow 77 Hospital Connect bus goes to Arrivals Square.
