Clinical Evaluation	

1. Objectives

- To ensure that a documented clinical evaluation of the medical exposure is produced for all procedures.

2. Responsibilities

- A clinical evaluation is recorded, for all procedures, by an entitled operator
- Staff must only perform clinical evaluation for medical exposures within their scope of entitlement.
- Staff who have been entitled for clinical evaluation, but are undergoing training, must maintain a record of the exposures that they are competent to evaluate, and this will be available for inspection.

3. Procedures

- The clinical evaluation, which may be electronic in form, is checked and signed or electronically authorised by an entitled operator.
- When the Practitioner is also concurrently the Operator they will still produce a report.
- For procedures where the clinical outcome is not immediately apparent, it shall be sufficient for the Operator carrying out the clinical evaluation to record whether the procedure was completed.

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
