- members of the Association of Medical Research Charities (AMRC)
- o Government organisations e.g. research councils, Health Directorates

In addition other grants/awards that meet the conditions of 'adoption' to, and are 'adopted' by, the NIHR portfolio, including Scottish-only studies (Adoption of non-commercial Scottish-only studies-SOP

(<u>nhsresearchscotland.org.uk</u>) will be considered to be eligible e.g.Industry funded (but not sponsored) awards, when instigated by the Investigator

Awards from organisations not on the CSO list, and not able to meet the conditions for NIHR portfolio adoption (as above), are not eligible for NHS support or treatment costs and therefore have to be fully funded (though can be from a variety of sources, including where departments agree to absorb any/or specific costs).
