Campus overview

The Queen Elizabeth University Hospitals (QEUH) Campus is located approximately 5 miles southwest of Glasgow City Centre. The adult hospital is integrated with the children's hospital with separate functions and entrances. Entry to both is via Arrivals Square. The map overleaf details where the major departments are located to allow easy access to your appointment. More information is available from our website and from the contact number above.

Walking and Cycling

There is a good network of pedestrian and cycling routes connecting QEUH to neighbouring communities, Govan Subway and Cardonald Railway station. There are multiple designated cycle parking areas located on the campus, including at Arrivals Square. There is also a public bike hire station facility at this location.

By Rail or Subway to Hospitals

Govan Subway Station: A 25 minute walk to Govan Road entrance (just over 1 mile). Buses to the hospital are First 34, 90, McGills 23, 23P and Stagecoach X19. Local taxis also available.

Cardonald Station: A 25 minute walk to Langlands Drive entrance (just over 1 mile). Buses to the hospital are First 34; McGills 17 and Colchri 25.

By Car

From the East or West of the City


M8 motorway to Junction 25. Follow signs for Clyde Tunnel (A739) for ¾ mile. Then follow signs for hospital. There are two entrances. Please see the map overleaf.

From north of the River Clyde

Go through the Clyde Tunnel (A739) and follow the signs for the hospital.

Car Parking and Disabled Parking

There are drop off and pick up bays in the hospital grounds for main department entrances. Patient and visitor parking is available, but car parks and surrounding areas are often busy, so please consider other travel options such as the bus or train, if they are a suitable alternative. Car parking is free but there is a 4-hour maximum stay. Car parks 1 and 2 are multi-storey car parks with dedicated floors for patients and visitors, with car park 2 offering access to all major departments. Both car parks have blue badge spaces. Car Park attendants are available to provide advice if required.
