By Rail to Hospital

Alexandria Railway station: is approximately 1 mile from the hospital. First Bus 1, Garelochhead Buses 306 and McColl's 340 operate to the hospital entrance. First Bus 206, Garelochhead Buses 305 and 309 operate to Alexandria Main Street.

The hospital has good connections from all major towns and neighbouring communities. The main entrance for vehicles is from Main Street, Alexandria.

Car parking and Blue Badge parking

There are drop off and pick up bays in the hospital grounds for main department entrances. Patient and visitor parking is available, but the car parks and surrounding areas are often busy, so please consider other travel options such as the bus or train, if they are a suitable alternative. Car parking is free, with disabled parking bays also available on site.
