



Kosenga remboursement po na transport soki oza Demandeur ya Asile

Soki oza Demandeur ya Asile, ata soki demande na yo endimami te, okoki kosenga remboursement po na transport na yo na service ya santé. Yango elingi koloba ete to ko remboursé transport na yo na buss, trains, to essence po na yo kokende na l'hopitalo.

Mwa buku oyo eyebisi yo nini osengeli o sala po na kosenga remboursement yango.

Po na ba information mosusu to po na kosenga remboursement na yo, kende na Cashier's Office. Ba l'hopitalo nioso baza na yango. Tuna moto ni moto asali kuna ba lakisa yo, to lakisa bango mwa buku oyo.

Nakoki kosenga remboursement ya nini?

Okoki kosenga remboursement ya buss, train, férrie, etc. – Bomba ba reçu na yo pe mema yango na Cashier's Office

Motuka – To kopesa ya talo par kilometre po na trajet na yo koyaka na l’hopitalo pe kozonga ndako.

Accompagnateur – Soki osengeli kozala accompagné na l'hopitalo, accompagnateur na yo pe akoki kosenga remboursement po na transport na ye (zuwa permission liboso)

Kaka transport ya moins-chère ekozala remboursé. To ko remboursé taxi te, sauf soki ozuwaki permission ya consultant na yo liboso, na tina ya ba difficulté na yo ya kotambola, par exemple.

Nasengeli komema nini?

Po na Cashier akoka kofuta remboursement na yo, osengeli omema -

1. Carte ya Demande ya Enregistrement (to Application Registration Card (ARC). Soki oza na yango naeno te, mema mokanda to lettre ya recépîcé na yo.



2. Mokanda ya rendez-vous na yo to Formulaire ya Reclamation na yo (Patients Traveling Expenses Claim Form).
3. Soki olingi remboursement ya buss, train, férrie, etc. mema ba recu na yo.

Tango okeyi na Cashier's Office, lakisa bango sima ya mwa buku oyo, oyo eyebisi bango nini basengeli kosala po ba remboursé transport na yo.



Information for Cashier's Office

This leaflet has been produced specifically for asylum seekers wishing to claim travel expenses.

Asylum seekers, including failed applicants, qualify for reimbursement of travel expenses.

They must produce an Application Registration Card (ARC) as proof of their entitlement which details their name, date of birth and nationality as well as their photograph and fingerprints.



If this has not yet been issued they must present a time limited, standard acknowledgement letter which can be used until they receive an ARC.

Note that only asylum seekers are eligible - this does not apply to other types of application such as those made under Human Rights legislation.

It is unlikely that an asylum seeker will have access to a bank account so reimbursements should be made in cash.
