In reference to slide 13, the term 'Oral Intake With Accepted Risk' (OIWAR) has now been replaced, in Greater Glasgow & Clyde and by the RCSLT (Royal Collage of Speech and Language Therapists) with the phrase 'Eating and Drinking with Risk' (EADAR). Please be aware that this terminology will now be used by health care professionals when discussing and referring to this situation.
