[New 'Patch and Go' pathway helps patients receive cardiac monitoring at home](#)

A new virtual pathway is now available across NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde for suitable patients presenting with palpitations, blackouts and faints.

Patch and Go enables patients to be discharged home with a small cardiac monitoring patch and remote monitoring equipment, rather than remaining in hospital for observation or waiting for further investigations.

The pathway combines specialist clinical support with remote monitoring technology, helping patients continue their normal daily activities while receiving ongoing cardiac assessment from home. Once monitoring is complete, recordings are analysed by the clinical team, who then contact patients with the outcome and any next steps.

As well as improving the patient experience, Patch and Go supports earlier, safer discharge from hospital and helps ensure beds remain available for patients who need them most.

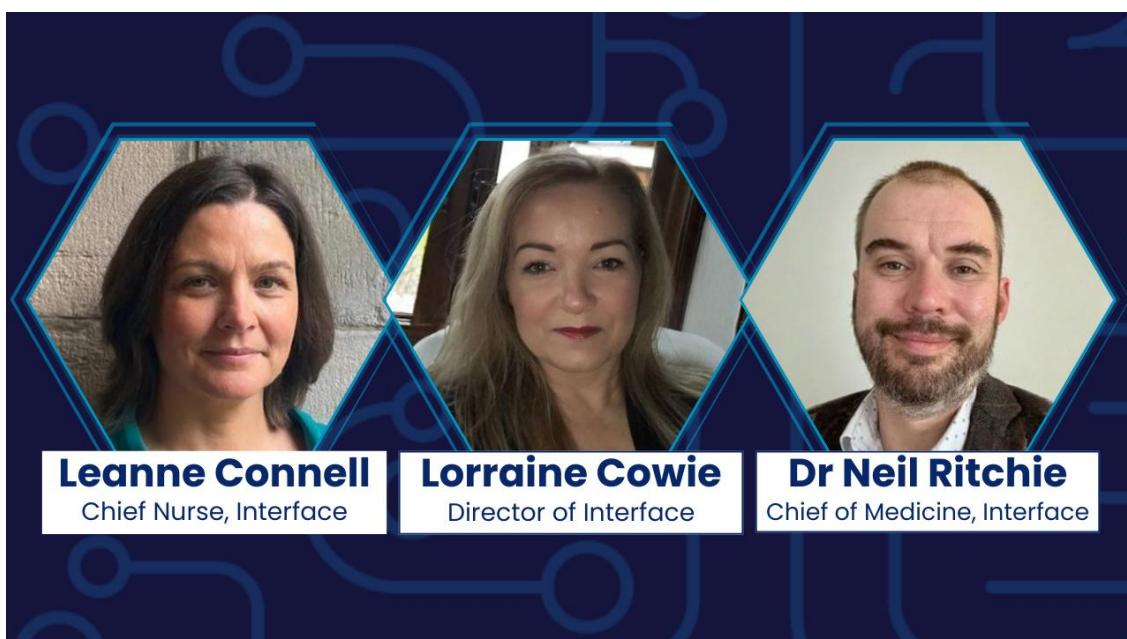
