

## **Supporting Cancer Care programme**

This programme is designed for learners who want to increase their knowledge and understanding of supporting people with cancer. The programme is suitable for the wider healthcare workforce, people living with cancer working in a supportive role, and health and social care professionals who may be new to working in a cancer environment.



## The modules included in this programme are:

- Induction
- Introduction to cancer and it's treatments
- Personalised care and support planning
- Effective communication
- Palliative and end of life care



## About the course:

The Supporting Cancer Care Programme takes 3 months to complete and consists of 4 modules, each of which contains approximately 4 hours of e-learning and 5 virtual classroom (3.5 hours per classroom) where participants are encouraged to discuss the learning they have applied in practice when supporting people with cancer.

The course will run 09:30am - 01:00pm on the following dates: 15th January 2026, 5th February 2026, 26th Febrary 2026, 19th March 2026, and 09th April 2026.
