IF patient meets criteria in Box A ask questions in Box B.

Box A
Ask?
1. Severe acute respiratory infection requiring admission to hospital.
2. Fever $\geq 38^{\circ}\text{C}$ or history of fever or cough.
3. Not explained by other infection or aetiology.

Box B
AND one of:
1. History of travel to or residence in areas <u>(see countries listed opposite)</u> where MERS-CoV could have been acquired in the 14 days before symptom onset.
2. Close contact with a confirmed MERS-CoV case in the 14 days prior to symptom onset while the case was symptomatic.
3. Healthcare worker based in ICU or HDU caring for ANY patients with severe acute respiratory infection.
