Laboratory Genetics

As part of our Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS) update, we notified our service users that as of 1st January 2023 we would be changing to paperless reporting.

Your practice can choose to either receive an email notification that the report has been uploaded to Clinical Portal or alternatively the report can be emailed directly to a secure practice email address. This should be a generic practice email and not to an individual staff member email address. For users who have access to Clinical Portal, reports can be accessed via the 'Genetics' section.

To ensure you receive either electronic notifications of the report being up uploaded onto Clinical Portal or electronic copies of the reports, please contact <u>geneticlabs@ggc.scot.nhs.uk</u> for the reporting preferences form. Please return completed forms by email or post. Our postal address along with further information about our services can be found on our website <u>West of Scotland Genetic Services</u>.

The laboratory is working with NHSGGC eHealth to try and send genetics reports via the EDT-Docman system. However, this requires a significant amount of development and therefor the interim measure above will be in place for all practices from 1st January 2023.
