3. Key Items of Discussion

Items for Action

Item 3. Non-voting Membership

The Board agreed the appointment of Ciorstaidh Reichle to the Integration Joint Board as NHS Board Staff Representative. Ciorstaidh Reichle is also appointed to the IJB Audit Committee.

Item 4. Financial Monitoring Report

The board noted the financial position as of 28th Feb 2025 (Period 11). It identified the IJB revenue budget is projecting an overall underspend of £0.023 (Health Service £0.027m and Social Care £0.050m).

Should this underspend continue to the end of the financial year, it will be transferred to appropriate reserves.

Item 5. Rolling Action List

The board noted the Rolling Action list, which highlights the main body of work to be considered by the IJB during 2025/26.

Item 6. HSCP Communication and Engagement Strategy 2025-27

The board were presented with the HSCP Communication and Engagement Strategy for 2025-27. The paper was received well and approved by the Board for implementation.

Item 7. Inverclyde ADP Strategy 2024-29

The board were presented with the Inverclyde Alcohol and Drug Partnership Strategy for 2024-29. The strategy sets out the 5-year vision and objectives for the ADP in Inverclyde. The paper was approved by IJB.

The board were presented with an update paper on the ongoing development of the Inverclyde Locality Planning Groups, highlighting a development day held in November 2024. The report was noted by the board.

Item 9. Strategic Partnership Plan – 6 Monthly Update

The board noted an update report in relation to progress made against the Inverclyde IJB Strategic Partnership Plan (2024-27). As of November 2024, of the 32 identified strategic actions 31 were assigned a Green RAG status. One action is yet to start.

Item 10. HSCP Equality Outcomes – 6 Monthly Update

The board noted an update report in relation to progress made against the Inverclyde IJB Strategic Partnership Plan (2024-27). As of November 2024, of the 18 identified actions, 16 have a Green Rag status, 1 Amber and 1 complete.

- Achievement of the Platinum Digital Telecare Implementation Award.
