1. Purpose of Paper

The purpose of this paper is to: inform the NHS Board on key items of discussion at the Glasgow City Integration Joint Board (IJB) held on [15 May 2024](#).

2. Recommendation

The Board is asked to note the key items of discussion at the recent meeting of the Glasgow City IJB on [15 May 2024](#) as set out below and seek further information or assurance as required.

3. Key Items of Discussion

- **Appointment of Interim Chief Officer**

The Integration Joint Board approved the appointment of Jacqueline Kerr as the Interim Chief Officer to Glasgow City Integration Joint Board.

- **Glasgow City IJB Membership Update**

A report was presented to provide an update on a number of changes to the membership of the Glasgow City IJB which included a change to a Council

Voting Member and the Third Sector representative. Members were also asked to consider the removal of an Acute Services representative from the membership as this has remained a vacancy since 2022. Members requested that this position remain on the IJB and Officers agreed to take forward with NHS GG&C to identify a replacement.

- **Interim Chief Officer Update**

The IJB received a verbal update on delayed discharges, noting the latest position on acute delays, including Adults with Incapacity. A significant increase in the number of delays recorded on the system during April was highlighted. An update was provided on Discharge to Assess and Intermediate Care placements.

An update was also provided on Homelessness and Asylum in terms of homeless applications and the total number of households in temporary accommodation and bed and breakfast accommodation, including those from asylum and refugee households.

- **Integration Joint Board - 2024-25 Budget Update**

A report was presented providing an update on the revenue budget for GCIJB for 2024-25 following approval of the budget by the IJB on 20 March 2024. Following discussion, the IJB noted the update provided in relation to the savings proposals; approved health savings of £4.034m, of which £3.160m will be delivered in 2024-25; and noted that savings proposals in relation to Hospital at Home and the balance of the saving in community health services within Children and Families will be deferred to the June IJB (*this was subsequently deferred to September following legal advice regarding the pre-election period*).

- **Sign Language and Interpreting Service (SLIS) Review**

The IJB received an update on the review of the Sign Language and Interpreting Service with proposals for the future delivery of the service. The IJB noted the outcome of the Review with the three options available and approved the option to develop a hybrid model with streamlining of the current service delivery.

- **Rapid Rehousing Transition Plan Update**

A report was presented to update the IJB on the successes of the Rapid Rehousing Transition Plan (RRTP) and to outline the challenges faced during its delivery. The report outlined the funding received for 2024/25 and sought approval for the proposals of how part of this funding will be allocated. The IJB approved the RRTP financial commitments set out within the report and to continue funding existing RRTP posts in 2024/25.

- **SG Funding for Improved MH Services for Children and Young People 2024-25**

The IJB were advised of the plan for the fourth year of investment in community mental health supports for children and young people by the Scottish

Government. The IJB approved the plan for the fourth year of funding for community mental health and wellbeing supports and noted the progress made, as noted in the Scottish Government progress report.

- **Whole Family Support through General Practice**

An update was provided to the IJB on the offer of additional funding for a whole family support and well-being through primary care pilot. The IJB approved expenditure on the Whole Family Wellbeing Funding (WFWF) Primary Care Programme as outlined in the report.

- **Social Care Planned Procurement 2024-25 and Commissioning Development Plan**

The IJB approved the planned procurement for the financial year 2024/25 and noted the progress and ongoing work in respect of the commissioning development plan.

- **Review of Private Sector Adaptation Policy - Opt out of Assisted Living**

A report was presented to update the IJB on the review undertaken of Private Sector Adaptations. The IJB approved the procedures document that will enable service users within private sector housing to “opt out” of the current managed adaptations service provided by Assisted Living (City Building).

- **Older Peoples Day Care Services - Internal Strategic Review**

The IJB were advised of the findings and recommendations of an internally conducted Strategic Review of Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership’s (GCHSCP) directly provided Older People’s Day Care Services. Approval was given for a wider strategic review of Older People Day Care Services following initial views on the current provision of the service, including a formal public consultation on future of day provision and subsequent EQIA.

- **GCHSCP Equality Outcomes 2024–2028 and Equality Outcome Mainstreaming & Progress Report 2024**

A report was presented outlining the three parts of the IJB’s equality duties: New Equality Outcomes for 2024 to 2028; reporting of mainstreaming of the equality duty; progress towards the Equality Outcomes for 2022 to 2024. The IJB approved the new Equality Outcomes 2024 to 2028 and noted an accessible user-friendly summary will be developed and published.

- **NHSGG&C Primary Care Strategy and Implementation Plan**

An update was provided on the development and implementation of the NHSGGC Primary Care Strategy and share the Strategy and Implementation plan. The IJB noted the report and that an annual update on delivery of the strategy will be provided.

- **Implementation of the next phase of Mental Health Strategy - Enhancing Community Services**

The IJB noted the update report on implementation of the next phase of Mental Health Strategy – Enhancing Community Services, including feedback from Healthcare Improvement Scotland; the proposed community engagement approach; governance arrangements; delivery plan and timescales.

- **National Care Home Contract Increase 2024-25**

The IJB received an update on the National Care Home Contract (NCHC) Increases (2024/25) and noted the approval by the Chief Officer and Chief Officer, Finance and Resources under delegated authority, on the grounds of urgency.

4. Issues for referral to Standing Committees of the Board or escalation to the NHS Board

There were no issues for referral to other Standing Committees or escalation to the NHS Board.
