Item 4. Financial Monitoring Report 2025/26 Period 11

The board were presented with the Period 11 Financial Monitoring Report. It highlighted and overall underspend of £0.736m. This is accounted from:

- a Social Care overspend of £0.309m
- a Health underspend of £1.045m

The report and recommended actions identified were approved by the board.

Item 5. Inverclyde HSCP Strategic Partnership Plan – Performance Update

The board were presented with the 6 Monthly HSCP Performance Report covering the period Oct 2025 to Mar 2026. The report demonstrated positive progress towards the HSCP Strategic Partnership Plan. Also presented was the first iteration of the Strategic Outcomes Framework. It was noted the framework remains under development but provides a strong indication of HSCP performance and the local impact of the Strategic Partnership Plan.

Item 6. Care at Home – Impact of Review

The board were presented with an evaluation report highlighting the impact the review of the Care at Home Workforce in 2023. Implemented due to increasing demand, high staff turnover and a poor perception of the role, the review set out to establish a more stable workforce through the design of a more professional, higher graded post.

Following implementation, the review has resulted in a range of key benefits including, reducing staff turn-over, improving workforce stability and service performance and positively impacting local poverty through the provision of higher paid posts.

The report was noted by the board and highlighted as an area of positive work.

The board were presented with the Chief Officers Report. The report presented a number of key updates from across the Partnership, including:

- Local celebrations for World Social Work Day
