3. Key Items of Discussion

3.1 COVID-19 Update

- A verbal update provided by the Interim Director of Public Health for Awareness
- The Committee noted the changes in prevalence within the community and Care Homes.
- Patients are no longer being tested when coming into hospital.
- The Committee were assured that if a new variant develops the LFT kids would detect it.

3.2 NHSGGC Vaccination Programme
