
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Issues to Address and Aims




- Gastroenterology waiting times above pre-COVID levels and continuing to rise
- 3000+ patients waiting more than 12 weeks; almost
 500 patients waiting more than 52 weeks
- Differing practice across the Sectors and not all services and pathways available within each Sector; examples:
 - 'Direct to test' not used in every Sector for similar patient groups
 - Nurse led IBS available in North and Clyde only
 - Dietetic Coeliac service available in South only
- Aim to standardise pathways across NHSGGC to provide consistency of approach and improve outcomes for patients


NHSGGC IBS ACRT Pathway – update 12 Oct 2021
