

### Attending the Chest Wall Clinic

Your child has been referred to the Chest Wall Clinic at the Royal Hospital for Children, Glasgow.

At this appointment your child may be seen by a Consultant Surgeon, Orthotist and Physiotherapist. Please ensure that your child is dressed in a top that is easy to remove so that the Chest Wall Team can easily examine their chest.

Depending on the underlying problem, your child may also receive an X-Ray, Clinical Photographs, 3D Scan or plaster cast mould of their chest. Any images will be held in their patient record but may also be used anonymously for teaching and publications. We will also hold a record of your child as part of a secure database. Please speak to a member of the Chest Wall Team if you have any questions regarding this.

Before attending your child's appointment, please take some time with them to complete the enclosed quality of life questionnaire and hand in at the Clinic 12 reception desk when you arrive.
