NES have created an education package to support learning for AHP practice educators who are planning to provide a Peer Assisted Learning (PAL) practice-based learning placement.

The aim of the learning is to provide participants with the knowledge and skills required for planning, delivering and evaluating a PAL placement.

The learning is designed to take place as a package and is split into 3 sections:

- 1. An introductory online presentation (10 minutes)
- 2. A main online presentation (1 hour)
- 3. An online interactive workshop which will take place on MS Teams (2 hours)
