

SALUD Dental Charting  
Project Update

September 2026

Project Overview

**SALUD Dental Charting Project** will introduce a modern electronic dental charting system across NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde Dental Hospital and School, **replacing paper-based records** and supporting the organisation’s wider Electronic Patient Record (EPR) strategy. The new system will **provide clinicians with secure, integrated digital charting, treatment planning, and clinical workflow tools**. It will also **improve access to patient information, reducing duplication and enhancing data quality**. All of these benefits support safer, more **efficient patient care**. Delivered in partnership with Titanium Solutions and integrated with key systems such as TrakCare and Clinical Portal, the project will be rolled out in phases across Glasgow Dental Hospital and School and associated clinics during 2026-2027.

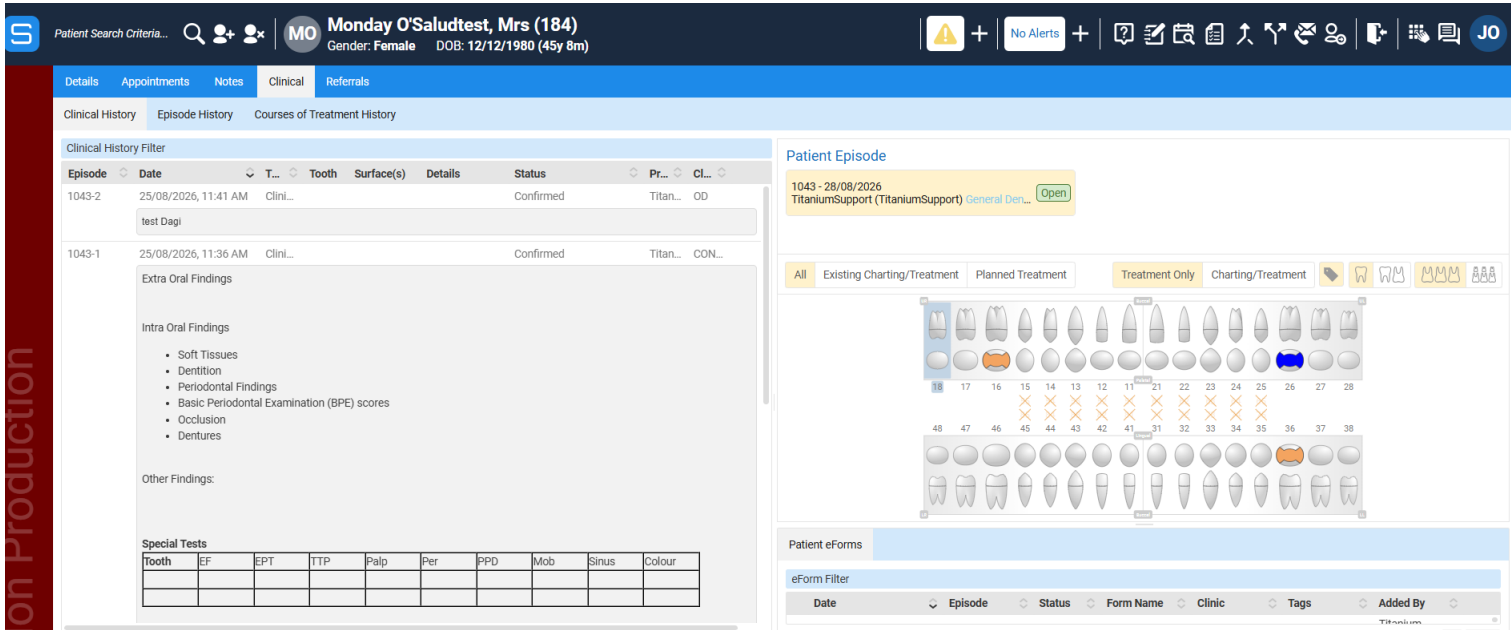


Image 1: First screen within the clinical tab

What’s been happening?

SALUD System Configuration

Since the last project update, the clinical workflows within the system have been signed off. Alongside this, the project team, supplier and clinicians have been working to refine the clinical code used within system and a minimum viable product has been reached/agreed using the SNOMED Clinical Terms (CT) coding terminology in preparation for SALUD go-live.

Integration with Existing Applications

Work continues to successfully integrate the system with existing applications such as TrakCare and SCI Store/Clinical Portal.

Testing

As we get closer to go-live, Digital Services are working with the supplier to test the system, refine it and resolve any data issues.

Training

A number of ‘train-the-trainer’ sessions have been delivered in August 2026 to prepare trainers for upcoming end-user training.

As of September, project team have been working to schedule and plan the end-user training programme which has been communicated with all staff, via email.

What’s next?

Training

The SALUD Training Programme booking for end-users is now live, and sessions will take place on weeks commencing:

- 21<sup>st</sup> September
- 28<sup>th</sup> September
- 5<sup>th</sup> October

All staff within Orthodontics and Restorative Departments will have now received communication to book onto a session, **make sure to secure your place as soon as possible**.

Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) and Oral Health Science (OHS) students will be allocated to suitable sessions in alignment with their timetable.

GO-LIVE!

System GO-LIVE is now estimated for **19<sup>th</sup> October 2026**.

The implementation of SALUD aims to transform the current process for record keeping within hospital dental settings to a modern, secure and efficient process for staff at the Glasgow Dental Hospital and School, this means a change to current ways of working and replacing paper-based processes with a digital workflow.
