From April 2025, the law around the **Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) scheme is changing**, meaning most of our roles will now be legally classed as "regulated work." As a result, up to 9,000 of our staff who haven't needed PVG membership before will now need to join the scheme.

The PVG scheme helps ensure people working with vulnerable groups (protected adults and/or children) don't have a known history of harmful behaviour.

Please discuss the impact with your team and let them know HR will be in touch if their work is now classified as regulated work.
