Change of outbound number for all NHSGGC telephony users

From Wednesday 27 September at 9.00am, NHSGGC will be changing their outbound telephone number from 0800 678 3393 to 0141 232 4000.

If you receive a call from the new 0141 232 4000 number you will know that this is an internal call from someone within NHSGGC.

As with the 0800 number, if the 0141 232 4000 number is called back there is a message that says 'this number does not accept incoming calls'.

By changing the outbound number we will no longer be charged for calls to the 0800 number.

Always Contact Us If Unable To Attend Your Shift

We are aware that circumstances can arise where you may be unable to attend a booked shift. If you find yourself in this situation, please always inform the staff bank contact centre as early as possible.

This enables the shift to be put back on the system to be potentially refilled by one of your colleagues. Contacting us to advise us you cannot attend, enables us to alert the service area, allowing them to consider options of reduced staffing levels.

Most importantly, it ensures we know you are safe and well, if you haven't arrived for a shift.

Your pension - New Pension Contribution Rates

We have received notification of new NHS pension contribution rates from 1 October 2023 - [Scottish NHS Circular 2023/11](#)

The main change is that the percentage contribution which members pay will be based on actual pensionable pay, rather than whole time equivalent salary. Around 40 per cent of members work part-time, and so most of those members will see a reduction in their contribution rates. However, other members will see an increase in their contribution rate. Member pension contributions are paid before tax, and so therefore reduce taxable pay.

The table below explains the new contribution rates for each salary range from 1 October 2023.

Pensionable earnings in 2022/23	Applicable contribution percentage rate from 1 October 2023
Up to £13,330	5.7%
£13,331 to £23,819	6.1%
£23,820 to £28,186	6.7%
£28,187 to £35,364	8.2%
£35,365 to £35,521	9.8%
£35,522 to £37,086	10.0%
£37,087 to £45,079	10.5%
£45,080 to £48,784	10.8%
£48,785 to £68,222	11.3%
£68,223 and above	13.7%
